CBK INDICATES THE MOST AFFECTED SECTORS BY THE PANDEMIC

COVID-19 pandemic and taking measures to manage the health crisis affected the economic activity of businesses in Kosovo. This is what the Central Bank of Kosovo says in the report "Quarterly Assessment of Macroeconomic Developments, Third Quarter 2020", adding that the hotel, trade and construction sectors were hit. On a sectoral basis, in the first half of 2020, the highest decline was recorded by the hotel and restaurant sector with 39%, construction with 35.5%, transport and storage with 33.1%, administrative and support activities with 22.8% and trade with 5 %. While, the activity of information, health and electricity supply has increased.
