GERMANY / WHY IMMIGRANTS ARE MOST AT RISK OF LOSING THEIR JOB

Even before the pandemic, it was known that migrants more often than Germans worked in precarious jobs, on short-term contracts or as temporary workers on loan. The advent of the Corona crisis hit them hardest first, especially in the first wave of lockdowns in Germany. The 400,000 asylum seekers currently employed, according to a study now published by the Institute for the Study of the Labor Market and Occupations, IAB - part of the Federal Employment Agency - were three times more likely than Germans to lose their jobs. More than 20,000 of them even lost their jobs. Refugees and migrants were also more affected by the shift to part-time work, and could work much less at home when the transition to the Home-Office was decided.

ITALY CHANGES THE MEASURES, THIS IS WHAT ALBANIANS WHO TRAVEL SHOULD KNOW

The Italian government has updated the rules for going there. Entry into Italy from Albania is allowed for Italian, EU, Schengen citizens and their family members, as well as long-term resident holders and their family members. Entry is also allowed for people who have a proven and stable emotional relationship, even if they do not cohabit with Italians, EU or Schengen area citizens and long-term residents who must arrive at their partner's home or residence in Italy. For those who do not fall into the aforementioned categories, entry is allowed only in the presence of the correct reasons, such as: need for work or study, health reasons, absolute urgency, return to residence.
